

How to Obtain an IRS Tax Return Transcript

You have several options to obtain an IRS tax return transcript. Go to www.irs.gov and select “Get Your Tax Record.”

1. To obtain a tax return transcript online, you will need to log in or create an ID.me account using the following information:

- Your SSN, date of birth, and mailing address from your latest tax return
- Access to your email account and a mobile phone number
- Government issued ID, such as a driver’s license

Get Transcript Online

Select “Get Transcript Online.” Once you have logged in with your ID.me account, you will then select “other” as the reason you need the tax transcript. You will then have access to download any transcript that has been processed for you.

For verification purposes, we need your 2022 Return Transcript.

2. If you are unable to get the transcript online, you can request the transcript by mail. To use this service, you will need:

- Your SSN or Individual Tax Identification Number (ITIN),
- Date of birth
- Mailing address from your latest tax return.

Get Transcript by Mail

Select “Get Transcript by Mail.” Once you fill in the requested information, you will be asked which type of transcript you want and for which year. Your tax return transcript should arrive by mail in 5-10 calendar days at the address the IRS has on file.
